## On Giving

Tony Campolo tells of being invited to speak at a ladies meeting. There were 300 women there. Before he spoke the president of the organization read a letter from a missionary. It was a very moving letter. In the letter the missionary expressed a need for \$4,000 to take care of an emergency that had cropped up.

So, the president of the organization said, "We need to pray that God will provide the resources to meet the need of this missionary. Brother Campolo, will you please pray for us?" Tony Campolo, who is very outspoken said, "No."

Startled, she said, "I beg your pardon!"

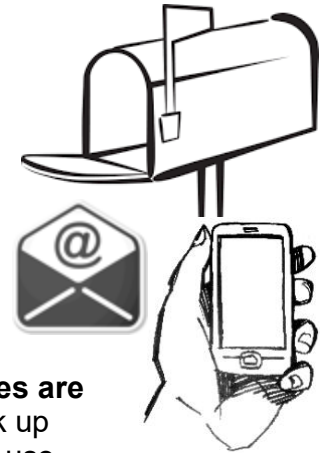
He said, "No, I won't pray for that, I believe that God has already provided the resources and that all we need to do is give. Tell you what I'm going to do. I'm going to step up to this table and give every bit of cash I have with me. If all of you will do the same thing, I think we'll see that God has already provided the resources."

The president of the organization chuckled a little bit and said, "Well, I guess we get the point. He is trying to teach us that we all need to give sacrificially." Campolo said, "No, that is not what I am trying to teach you. I'm trying to teach you that God has already provided for this missionary. All we need to do is give it." So, he emptied his pockets and then looked at the president of the organization. Reluctantly, she opened her purse and took out all of her money, which was about \$40, and put it on the table. One by one the rest of the ladies filed by and put their money on the table, too. When the money was counted, they had collected more than \$4,000."

Tony Campolo said, "Now, here's the lesson. God always supplies for our needs, and he supplied for this missionary, too. The only problem was we were keeping it for ourselves. Now let's pray and thank God for His provision."

Update from the Columbarium Committee:

### Everyone's help is needed!

Our Memorial Garden is very close to reality, with funds for the first construction phase almost all committed. There will be up-to-date dollar figures in Sunday bulletins, and a display in the front entry near the elevator will have more information. Soon there will be a schedule of speakers after church on Sundays discussing health care and end of life decisions.

There are many in our congregation who have burial plots elsewhere or who are not at the time in their lives where they are financially or emotionally ready to make this end-of-life decision. And yet, they have asked how they can help support this ministry.

Church members have already given donations towards the general columbarium fund and memorial gifts have been received which are dedicated to the Memory Garden. Others have purchased spaces on the memorial wall to honor baptisms, confirmations, years of staff service or membership, etc. Hopefully, the Memorial Walls will be a place for us to do a memory walk through the years of our faith journey with names of present and former church members. Or it may be more personal with names of godparents, grandparents, or parents inspiring our faith growth.
