Faith Mentoring is the part of confirmation Christ program Lutheran Church. Confirmation students select adult mentors who will faith/life discuss with them issues during the

confirmation process and will meet with them during Lent.

Being a Faith Mentor is a 3-year commitment where you meet weekly during the 5 weeks of Lent for 20-30 minutes before or

after worship with your student discuss a specific faith/life issue. guides Discussion provided for mentors for all weeks. You will each meet year during Lent with your student during their 3 years Confirmation. There a short Faith is Mentor Orientation meeting where we
